French 7 is the first half of a two-year course that will earn you your first high school credit. In French 7, students learn greetings, numbers, calendar, food, family, school and work vocabulary and describing words as well as how present-tense verbs work. By the end of the year, students are expected to answer simple questions about themselves and their likes and dislikes in French, read and answer questions about simple short texts, and write a 20-word note.

Course Description *

French 8 is the second part of a two-year course that will earn you your first high school credit. To receive this credit you must pass the course with a 65% AND the final exam with a grade of 65%. In this course, students continue building proficiency by learning clothing and household vocabulary, television, movies and travel vocabulary as well as how the preterite (past) tense works. As part of the final exam, students are expected to sustain a short conversation, read and answer document-based questions, and write a 30+ word paragraph in French.

Course Description *

French 9, also known as French II in neighboring districts, is a high school credit-earning course for those students who have passed French 7 and 8 and also passed the Checkpoint A Regional Assessment Exam. In French 9, students will review all of the skills learned previously as well as further expanding their vocabulary and adding the imperfect tense to our toolkit. By the end of the year, students are expected to maintain a conversation of at least 5 exchanges with their teacher and write an essay of 65 or more words.

Course Description *

This course is offered through JCC's EDGE program. This humanities course is the first half of a 2-semester sequence that constitutes an introduction to French language and cultures. It begins with a review of present tense. The student will continue to develop the four basic skills of listening comprehension, speaking, and reading, and writing with an emphasis on spoken communication. This course satisfies a SUNY General Education learning outcome. Students will advance oral and written proficiency in French language which will enable them to communicate in French; increase working knowledge of elementary French primarily through aural-oral practice based on systematic study and application of French grammar. The student will apply French grammar in conversation and in writing; refine the four basic skills of listening comprehension, speaking, reading and writing at the elementary level; continue to learn how to apply the French language to many everyday situations and occurrences; increase basic vocabulary, including the use of expressions and idioms; employ principles of French pronunciation; continue to develop knowledge of civilization, cultures, customs, and way of life of French-speaking peoples.
