

Principal's Report

- Senior Class Funds Plan—Mr. Storey met with the senior class advisors, Mrs. Costello and Mrs. Billman regarding the plans for the funds that the class has raised. The senior trip has been canceled. The class will use their class funds towards items such as yearbook, class clothing, possibly prom and scholarships for the seniors.
- o Plan for PSAT Testing—The PSATs are scheduled for January 26th. The juniors were notified via ParentSquare as to where and when the test was being administered. Accommodations have been made to maintain transportation, social distancing and cohort groups during the test.
- o Cohort D (Remote Learner) Report-These are the students that are 100% remote. Parents have made this request for their student(s) to be placed in cohort D. It is required for those struggling students to return to in-person schooling. Currently, 43 families (76 students) are in cohort D.
- O School Musical Report—The school musical will be virtual this year. The musical is "Junie B. Jones-The Musical". The dates for the musical are March 26th and 27th. Tickets must be purchased to view the live streamed show. Logistics for the sale of the tickets are still being worked out. Social distancing and cohort guidelines are being followed during practices and the show. Musical is not a high-risk sport.

Superintendent's Report

Superintendent's Update—Ms. Collins reported to the Board on concerns for student performance and attendance. Administration is following these concerns very closely and are working with the teachers to help identify students that are struggling or not participating. Administration has a plan to get the students the help that may be needed.
