WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, Governor Andrew Cuomo issued Executive Order 202.4, which mandates that effective March 17, 2020 through April 15, 2020, the District must allow non-essential personnel to be able to work from home or take leave without charging accruals, except for those personnel essential to the District's response to the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, the District was ordered close by a declaration of a local state of emergency on March 18, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to New York General Municipal Law Section 92, New York Education Law Section 1709(16), and Executive Order 202.4, the Board shall provide paid leave to all non-essential, non-aligned employees on regularly scheduled workdays, at their regular rates of pay, who are ready, willing and able to work as determined by the Superintendent of Schools from March 18, 2020 through the period that Executive Order 202.4 remains in effect and any period that extends the effect of Executive Order 202.4; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all essential personnel who are ready, willing and able to work, as determined by the Superintendent of Schools, shall perform such duties within the scope of their title during the period that Executive Order 202.4 remains in effect, including any prior school closures, and any period that extends the effect of Executive Order 202.4 whether remotely and/or in the District.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT(S)

Superintendent Collins gave the following report:

- NYSED Required COVID-19 Plans Under the Governor's Executive Order every school district submitted three plans as a condition of school closing. These are: The Continuity of Learning Plan, the Child Care Plan and the School Food Service Plan.
 - Continuity of Learning On Tuesday, March 17, 2020, students learning packets went out to homes across the district. Last week, teachers began making a shift to technology instructional techniques and working closely with Scott and Ashleigh on these approaches.
 - Food Service Distribution Plan Meal counts have increased from 130 students to 202 students participating. Every student is getting breakfast and lunch Monday through Saturday. This week 2,424 meals were distributed.
 - O Child Care for Essential Workers Our Child Care Plan for parents of Essential Workers is through the Watertown YMCA School Aged Child Care Program. The YMCA will provide emergency childcare for schoolage children at 10 sites and at the YMCA Daycare in Watertown for daycare-aged children. Only children of workers in healthcare, emergency services and other Essential personnel are eligible to participate in the emergency childcare.
- Food Pantries Thanks to Watertown Urban Missions, the Belleville Henderson Communities have temporary Food Panties. Thanks to the efforts of Mary Forrester, Colleen and Mike Bellinger, Rusty Corron, and Jay Canzonier, we have been able to establish two temporary local Food Pantries using government surplus foods. Mary and her husband used Jay's refrigerated truck to pick up the food and distributed it to the Belleville Henderson Fire Department where Rusty's family helped Mary and her family unload the food. They also delivered food to Colleen's Cherry Tree Ice Cream Shop. Mr. Adam Miner has secured a donation of Cheese sticks for the Food Pantries from a local farmer. Henderson Fire Department could not extend an offer to host the pantry and Mr. and Mrs. Bellinger stepped up to support this worthy cause. Marcie Matthews and Rebecca Eastman are providing support to these two sites on M, W, and F from

Date: April 6, 2020

10 AM to Noon. The Belleville Fire Department opened the pantries last Saturday from 12 to 5 PM. These food pantries are open to anyone who is in need of food.

- Flattening the Curve The Governor's Executive Order is very clear that only "Essential Personnel" are allowed to be at school during this pandemic. Food Service Workers and custodians are Essential Personnel. Transportation workers are Essential Personnel. Non-Essential personnel are those persons who do not have to be at school to do their job, like teachers, administrators, and CSEA persons who are not needed to perform an essential duty at school. All non-essential personnel have been directed to either work from home or wait to be called to report for another duty at school.
- Continuity of Learning Teachers are working from home and reaching out to students and parents using technology and phones. Our teachers have been working together and with the support of Mr. Storey and Mrs. Barnhart-Burto and the Jefferson Lewis BOCES to create and establish virtual classrooms. This past week we deployed 150 Chromebooks out to 150 students who express through a parent survey that they needed these devices to complete their school work and to be able to work with their teachers online and through distance learning.
- NYS ELA and Math Assessments were cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Today the NYSED and Chancellor Rosa announced that the Regents will be cancelled this year.
- School Election and School Budget The Election and School Budget Vote has been pushed out to June 1, 2020 by the Governor's Executive Order. We are awaiting further details from the NYS Education Department on these timelines given the change in dates.
- State Aid On April 1, 2020, NYS Legislators approved a budget for 2020-2021. We are awaiting further guidance on how to precisely to interpret this information.
