- Authorizes the District Treasurer or Business Manager to sign checks.
- Authorizes the Superintendent to apply for grants in aid.
- Authorizes the Central Treasurer to sign activity fund checks.
- Authorizes the Superintendent to make budgetary transfers up to \$20,000.00 of an appropriation when necessary.
- Authorizes attendance of School Board members, the School District Clerk, Business Manager, and the Superintendent to local and state conferences with expenses paid by the district and further authorizes the Superintendent to approve attendance at state and local conferences.
- Agrees to participate in the St. Lawrence/Lewis BOCES Cooperative Purchasing Programs in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the "Cooperative Purchasing Agreement" for the 2023-2024 school year.
- Establishes a petty cash fund in the amount of \$100.00 for the school year 2023-2024. The District Treasurer will be responsible for the petty cash fund.
- Sets the tuition rate as follows for the 2023-2024 school year:
   \$500 each student/per year
   \$750 per family/per year
- Sets the mileage rates as follows for the 2023-2024 school year:
   \$.50 per mile if choosing not to use a school vehicle
   \$.58 per mile if a school vehicle is not available
- Sets the mileage rate for the 2023-2024 school year for use of a bus at actual cost to district.
- Approves the loan of monies to the Lunch Fund and the Federal Fund up to \$25,000 each to meet payrolls and expenses until State Aid is received.
