

- Administrative Coordinator's Report
 - o Mrs. Barnhart-Burto gave an update on the soccer intramural programs for grades 7-12 that have begun.
 - o Hot Spots for families that have requested them are being distributed.
 - Students in grades 6-12 have been issued a Panther Email directions were distributed and Mrs. Barnhart-Burto has been assisting those that are having difficulties or questions.
 - Administration and teachers have been using ParentSquare to push out communication to families. Training for teachers has been provided.
 Mrs. Vaughn asked about submitting the student questionnaire on Mondays. Mrs. Barnhart-Burto encouraged all parents to routinely submit on Mondays, however if you forget it should be done asap.
- Business Manager's Report
 - o Mr. Magovney updated the Board on the maintenance and transportation continues to clean the building and busses.
 - Mr. Magovney also provided an update on the current financial condition of NYS and its impact on State Aid. The Board appreciates the updates.
 - He also reported the progress on the current tax collection. We are right about where we were for collection as last year.
- Principal's Report
 - o Mr. Storey reported on the attendance procedure for all students.
 - O He also reported that student pick up and drop off are working well. As well as the unloading and loading of the busses. It takes about 8-10 minutes to unload the busses in the morning, this includes the taking of their temperature. Mr. Storey gave kudos to Phil for the organization on the transportation end. The parents and teacher have cooperated as well to make the entire operation run smoothly.
 - o Most of the "kinks" in the master schedule have been worked out.
 - Lunch is going very well too. Lunch is delivered to the classrooms.
 Every student is served lunch with in an hour. The coverage for staff lunches has been challenging, but most issues have been resolved.
 - Lockers have been assigned to students in grades 7-12. The assigning has been spaced out as much as possible and the grades have been intermingled to avoid congregation at lockers. Students can begin using the lockers this Thursday. Teacher in grades 3-6 have requested to postpone the use of lockers for their students. The students use their desks or book bags to store their items.
- Superintendent's Report
 - O Superintendent Collins reported that immunizations are still required by the NYSDOH for all students enrolled in school. This includes students that are remote learners. Letters have been sent home to parents for those students that are not up to date on their immunizations.

- She also informed the Board that PIVOT program offers an EAP Service (Employee Assistance Program Service). This is a service for teachers and staff who are in need of counseling for a variety of areas.
- She is also working a press release for the America's Farmers Grow Rural Education Grant that Mrs. Bean presented to the Board at the last meeting.
