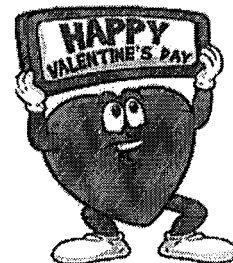

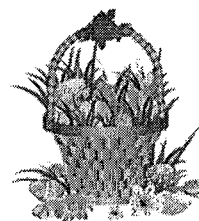

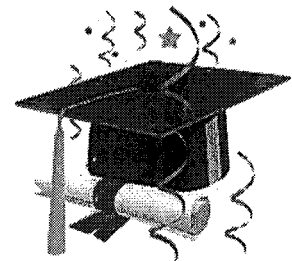

Dear Panther Community,

First, I want to take the opportunity to wish all of you a happy holiday season. It's no secret that the 2020-21 school year has been like no other that we have experienced in our lifetime. There has been a host of changes and adjustments that we all have had to make in order to get this year off and running successfully.

That is why I wanted to take a moment to thank all of you for your patience, understanding and hard work for the successful start to this year. This includes our students, faculty, families and surrounding community. It is because of you that we have been able to implement the proper safety protocols and recommendations to allow for in-person instruction to occur and limit the transmission of COVID-19 within our school building. This is a testament to your dedication to helping the Belleville Henderson Central School District create a safe and educational learning environment for all our students. This would not have been possible without your help and we are thankful for your support. As we enter the remaining months of the school year, I want to assure you that all the safety protocols outlined in our Reopening Plan, such as social distancing, mask wearing, and thorough cleaning of classrooms & school busses, will continue.

I also want to take a moment to address questions that many of you have regarding the possibility that we may be required to test students and faculty in the near future should the District find itself within a designated "Cluster Zone". In recent weeks, New York State has publicly stated that it will prioritize keeping schools open for in-person instruction, a goal that is shared by our Board of Education.

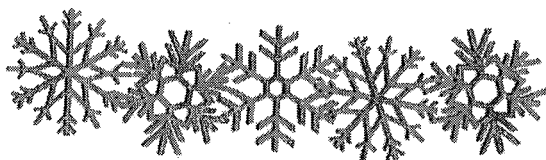
Should the District find itself in a Yellow, Orange or Red Zone, New York State Department of Health guidelines dictate that a certain percentage of students, faculty and staff must be tested over a one month period in order for the District to remain open for in-person instruction. This includes 20% for a Yellow or Orange Zone and 30% for a Red Zone. Since these new guidelines were announced, we have been working with Jefferson County Public Health and Jefferson-Lewis BOCES as to just how that testing will occur. At this time, we can tell you that we are planning for such testing to take place at the school should it become necessary for us to test. Once other details of the plan are finalized, we will share them with you, our Panther Community.

On behalf of our Board of Education and Administrative Team, I want to wish all of you a happy, healthy and safe holiday season and a wonderful 2021. Together, we are Panther Strong!

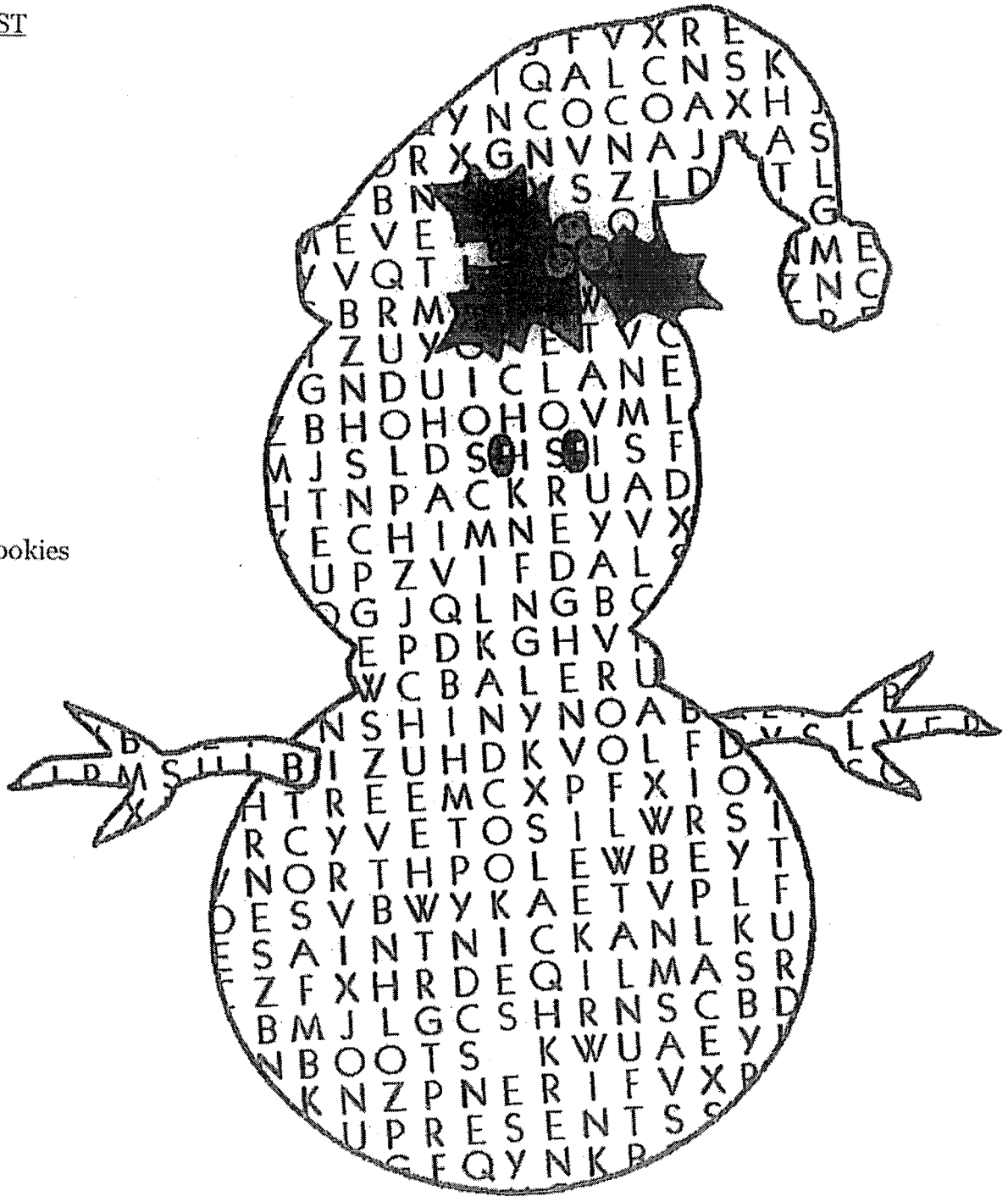
Please be aware that contact tracing calls can come from Jefferson County Public or New York State Contact Tracing. If you have caller ID, these are not scam calls.



CHRISTMAS SNOWMAN PUZZLE

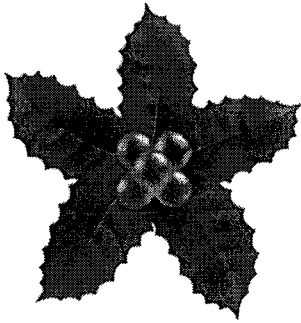
