Old Business:

Secretary's Report: Minutes from November's meeting were reviewed by all in attendance. Rebecca Eastman made a motion to accept the minutes. Crystal Dewitt seconded the motion.

Memberships: Lori reported 36 paid members representing: 5 seniors and 12 teachers. Lori mentioned the ice cream competition for most members by December 1st does not seem to be working. From all the elementary classes, members ranged from 1 to 4 per class. Lori did not feel it was appropriate to award an entire class when only 4 out the the 20 something kids were members. Treasurer's Report: Kim reported the following balances: \$2,056.70 Checking, \$7,377.31 Savings, \$446.00 Petty Cash for a total of \$9,880.01. Kris Kringle account balance is \$4,603.02. Since last meeting she had deposited \$90.00 in membership fees and paid out \$150.00 to Senior Class for last June's Field Days, \$301.32 for Apple Watch for Raffle and \$100.00 Award for Raffle. Carrie Eastman made a motion to accept the report. Nikki Henry seconded the motion. Crystal Dewitt turned over \$30.00 in donations from the donation jar. Lori turned over all the Kris Kringle money which will be deposited - see Kris Kringle Section for details.

Box Tops: Janelle reported that she just deposited \$651.80 and is working on the next submission by March 1st. Kate Costello stated that the winning classrooms from the 1st round will get their rewards after the winter break.

Self Defense Course: Kristine Maloney has asked for three dates to bring back to her instructors. Another discussion was had and it was decided that this was not meant for the elementary students and should be offered to 7th graders and up as well as adults on a non-school day. She also wanted to know if just demonstrations or hands-on. Janelle is going to talk to Scott Storey and get this finalized.

Due to the snow day on Wednesday, Dec. 13th - we had the store open on Friday, Dec 15th to allow students their 3 day to shop. Items were donated again this year by Kristine Maloney, Stephanie Race, Linda Williams and Scott Storey's mother. Lori also used funds to purchase 1 set of needed prizes for the Belleville Field Days from Oreintal Trading Company during Black Friday to take advantage of free shipping - copy of invoice was turned over.

After Prom Event - Per Emma and Jayda - stated that at class meeting this was discussed and senior class is not interested. Prom is to be held on June 2nd.

New Business:

Traveling Show: It was mentioned that we should check into a traveling show to be put on for the elementary students. More brain storming is to done.

Kids Night Out: Carrie Eastman/Kate Costello reported that they made \$1,000.00 for signups and still do not have the profits yet from the raffle baskets. Booster Club did food and there were crafts/face painting in the cafeteria. They have had a very good response from this event. Prices discussed were: \$10.00 for first kid w/ \$5.00 for each additional OR just \$5.00 for each student. Carrie and Kate have offered to arrange another event this time as a fundraiser for PTO. They are going to meet with Scott to get dates. They are thinking of doing something around Easter or Mothers Day for the crafts.
