Fred Laemmerman Memorial Scholarship Criteria

Established in 1980 the Fred Laemmerman Memorial Scholarship is dedicated to the memory of our first Grand Knight. To honor him the Msgr. T. Walter Cleary Council will annually give two scholarships to reward graduating seniors of the St. Cecilia's and Queen of Heaven parish community. These scholarships will be awarded to one student from both the South Jefferson School District and the Belleville Henderson School District. These academic and church community-based scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$150 each. The winner of each scholarship will be determined by a four-member committee of Brother Knights, one of the members of this committee must be the council Priest. The committee appointed by the Grand Knight must have at least one Brother Knight from the Saint Cecilia and Queen of Heaven parishes. If a committee member has a child or relative being considered for the scholarship, he must recuse himself from the committee and the Grand Knight will appoint a new member to the committee. If after two votes there is a tie, the Grand Knight will cast a vote to break the tie. Only one scholarship will be given at each school. If no one from either school applies then that scholarship will not be given. Scholarship applications will be submitted to the parish Priest and are due by the end of parish business hours the last Monday of May. Winners must be announced at the June Knights of Columbus business meeting.

The candidate for each scholarship will be determined by combination of each of the six criteria areas. They are listed in order of importance.

- 1. Parish Participation. Is there mass attendance, Sundays and holy days, following through with confirmation ministry. Other examples would be singing, taking collection, altar serving, religious education, youth ministry or attending church dinners (i.e. Seder Dinner).
- 2. Academics. Does not have to be a perfect student but someone who takes their learning seriously. Do you belong to any faith-based clubs at school?
- 3. Participations Outside of Parish Community. Is student participating in activities outside church, but related to faith such as March for Life, march with parishioners in local parade, Youth Rally, Mystery Players or Camp Guggenheim.
- 4. Vocations. Is the applicant entering a seminary or nunnery.
- 5. Participation in Knight of Columbus or Ladies of Saint Cecelia's/Queen of Heaven Events. Assisting groups with rummage sales, dinners and picnics, or selling raffle tickets.
- 6. Personal Life. Does this person represent their Catholic faith to the best of their ability? Do they strive to live their faith daily?
