Thank you for your interest in applying for the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) Scholarship.

We feel that the interest of the parents in their child's education and activities is an important factor in the student's involvement in school and the community. Therefore, we require parent participation and active memberships in the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) in order for the student to be considered for this scholarship.

Parent participation from seventh through twelfth grade will be considered. Student participation in school and community activities from seventh through twelfth grade will also be used as criteria. Only the information submitted on the application will be used.

To be eligible for consideration, a parent's and/or student's involvement must include:

- At least one year of membership by December 1st of the student's senior year.
- Attendance during at least one PTO meeting during the student's senior year.
- Volunteering for at least one PTO-sponsored activity during the student's senior year (i.e. Ag. Fair, Kids' Night Out, fundraising, Kris Kringle, etc.).
- The deadline for submitting the application for this year is May 3, 2019. Five points will be deducted for each day the application is late, and NOTHING will be accepted after May 17, 2019.

Scholarship Guidelines (For students 7th-12th Grade):

- Participating seniors will receive \$5 per point earned
- Max of \$1,000 per student
- Scholarship deadline will be the first Friday in May, with nothing accepted after the third Friday in May.
- 5 points will be deducted for each day late AFTER the first Friday in May (counting business days only).
- If you are a PTO member and you have a child graduating this year, you are NOT eligible to serve on the PTO Scholarship Committee, with the exception being the PTO treasurer.
